Attention for All Applicants

- 1. Attention for All Applicants
 - (1) The person with multiple nationalities including the Korean nationality or the stateless person is not considered as a foreigner.
 - (2) Only the curriculum of the regular school acknowledged by the education related laws of the corresponding country is acknowledged.
 - (3) The eligibility is determined based on Tuesday February 28, 2017.
- 2. Application Materials
 - (1) The original copy is required for all application materials. Under unavoidable circumstances, copies that are verified with the original by the issuing institute can be submitted; however, the original must be submitted after the registration of accepted applicants. All application materials will not be returned.
 - (2) Documents written in other languages than Korean or English must have a notarized translation (to Korean or English) attached.
 - (3) For high school period the applicant attended in Korea, the applicant shall submit the school records instead of the certificate of enrollment or the grade transcript.
 - (4) If the name of the applicant on the documents submitted is different, the applicant shall attach the verification of identity issued by the court of the corresponding country or the head of a government organization.
 - (5) The sponsor basically indicates the parents of the applicant. If the applicant's relative or the third party (the applicant's countryman or Korean only) becomes the sponsor, the document that proves the relationship with the applicant shall be submitted. (Illegal immigrant in the Republic of Korea is ineligible.)
 - (6) The contact information provided in the application form should be viable during the period of admission process. If changed, it needs to be reported immediately to the Office of Admissions, and the applicant is responsible for any disadvantages that arise from the loss of contact. (Provide the contact information inside Korea, if possible.)
 - (7) Accepted applicants who submitted the certification of expected graduation (completion) shall obtain "Apostillization" or the "Certification of Overseas Institutions" or "Consul Confirmation" at a diplomatic office of the applicant's country and submit it to Office of Admissions (#103, Administration Building) as of Tuesday February 28, 2017. (For Chinese students, submit "Verification of Academic Achievement" or "Consul Confirmation.")
- 3. Additional Notes
 - (1) Those who are considered to have insufficient scholastic ability for Seoul Women's University will not be admitted and most courses are offered in Korean.
 - (2) Those who failed to submit application documents or submitted false documents or applicants who are illegal immigrants or have illegal immigrant parents are excluded from the application procedure.
 - (3) If the information provided on the application materials is found false, if the applicant is found ineligible, or if the applicant was qualified admitted in any other dishonest method, the admission can be cancelled even during the semester.
 - (4) All students entering Seoul Women's University must complete the courses: Introduction to Christianity (2 credits), Pious Meeting (new admission: 6 semesters, transfer admission: 2 semesters) to establish wholesome sense of values and develop leader's qualities based on Christian spirit alongside the Bahrom Education 1, 2, and 3 which are based on community life as compulsory courses (Bahrom Education 2 and 3 for students transferring to undergraduate course).
 - (5) Refer to the decision of Seoul Women's University Admission Application Management Committee for matters not specified in this handbook.

Attention for Accepted Applicants

- 1. Do not lose the receipt for tuition payment for it needs to be presented to the Korean Consulate or Immigration Office to obtain the student visa (D-2).
- 2. The standard admission letter is issued to those who are accepted and registered. Do not lose the admission letter for it will not be reissued.
- 3. To apply for the student visa, the applicant shall apply for the visa at the Korean Consulate or Immigration Office by submitting the standard admission letter and other required documents.
- 4. The student who obtained the student visa (D-2) must immediately apply for alien registration at the Immigration Office in Seoul (for those who are outside after arriving in Korea).
- 5. The accepted student shall submit 1 copy of the student visa (D-2) and 1 copy of alien registration to the Office of Admissions of Seoul Women's University.
- 6. The accepted student shall be insured before registration and shall submit a copy of certificate of medical insurance subscription. If it is difficult to subscribe for a medical insurance before registration, the certificate shall be submitted at least before the admission.
- 7. If the student is rejected in the visa process, the student shall prepare the following documents and apply at the Office of Admissions of Seoul Women's University for a refund of the registration fee. (If the student cannot visit in person, then the refund can be made to the applicant's parents or sponsor only)
 - 1 Statement of Withdrawal (Attached Form)
 - Receipts for tuition and fees (original)
 - 1 copy of bank account under the applicant's name (or the name of a parent or the sponsor on paper) and 1 copy of identification

 - A. TOPIK Level 3 or above
 - B. Completion of regular course at the SWU Korean Language Center
 - C. Person who has other records that can prove one's Korean skills
 - ♦ Successful applicants must achieve TOPIK Level 4 or above before graduation
 - Successful applicants must complete Korean courses which will be assigned by the school according to their Korean language skill

[Transfer Admission]

- (1) Parents and applicants are all non-Koreans [including the case where the father (or mother) and the applicant are Taiwanese]

- (3) Eligible applicants who meets language requirements

 - ♦ Successful applicants must complete Korean courses which will be assigned by the school according to their Korean language skill

3. Application Method

[New Admission]

- (1) The Application is received by admission units, and students admitted to the Divisions (such as Division of Communications & Media, Division of Chemistry and Bio-Environmental Sciences etc.) will decide their major through a fixed procedure.
- (2) Applicants can apply to the Division of Pre-Majors (Social Sciences / Natural Sciences) only as the second preference instead of first preference and must choose the first preference and then choose the Division of Pre-Majors (Social Sciences / Natural Sciences) as the second preference.
- (3) If admitted to the Division of Pre-Majors (second preference), the student can choose the major as the following:
 - Social Sciences: within College of Humanities or College of Social Sciences(Department of Educational Psychology, Human Movement Science excluded) or Department of Business Administration, Fashion Design & Marketing, Digital Media Design and Applications, Information Security, Software Convergence
 - Natural Sciences : within College of Natural Sciences or Department of Business Administration, Fashion Design & Marketing, Digital Media Design and Applications, Information Security, Software Convergence
 - The student may not choose a Physical Education & Fine Arts major even when the student had chosen Physical Education & Fine Arts as the first preference.

[Transfer Admission]

- (1) Transfer admission applicants cannot apply to Division of Pre-Majors (Social Sciences / Natural Sciences).
- (2) Applicants applying to the School of Communications & Media should decide the major from Digital Media & Visual Communication or Journalism or Business Communication.

9. Application Fee: KRW 50,000

- (1) Refund Policy for Application Fee and Amount of Refund
 - A. If the amount paid exceeds the application fee: The exceeding amount
 - B. If the applicant was not put through the admission procedure due to Seoul Women's University's fault: The entire amount paid
 - C. If the applicant was not able to go through the admission procedure due to natural disaster: The entire amount paid
